### **Artist's Windows Projects**

In response to the upcoming federal election, and in the keeping with the tradition of artist's windows projects made famous by Pages Bookstore and the Partisan Gallery of Toronto~ and Printed Matter, Franklin Furnace, and the New Museum in New York City, Lake Galleries is pleased to announce that it will be presenting over a six week period, three artist's windows devoted to the October 25th election. The schedule for the artists is Mendelson Joe September 16 to September 29; Allan MacKay September 29 to October 13~ Mike Constable October 13 to October 27.

Allan MacKay's window, titled *Question Proof*, will be text oriented paraphrasing a line borrowed from the Rhinoceros Party, 'Is it true that no matter who you vote for the government always gets in?' This skepticism is somewhat tempered by MacKay's answer in the representation of the publication *The Canadian Parliamentary Guide, Spring, 1993 edition* which contains a complete list of the members of parliament who have been elected since confederation. By treating individual pages, and the book itself, to his trademark wax1pigment process, Mackay submits tangible evidence, or proof, of the election process.
